

## **LOCAL PROTESTERS UNREPENTANT**

The police are investigating connections between protesters and the murder of Brad Manning. Manning, a local hunter, was found dead this morning after publicly confronting protesters in front of the Mountainlair yesterday afternoon. John Maples, the organizer of the event, had personally clashed with Manning, and still sported the black eye from their encounter.

"I don't regret anything I said," stated Maples, referring to his group's slogan, "Hunters Should Be Hunted". "I don't want any human to be murdered, obviously, but this is poetic justice."
